Draft text

From line 72 to 76:

- ~~supports the production of batteries in Europe, which constitutes an opportunity to reindustrialise our territories and produce useful, qualified and stable jobs. ‘Made in Europe’ batteries should continue to be exempted from state-aid regulation until the competitiveness gap with foreign actors has been filled;~~
- The European Union should develop more Important Projects of Common European Interest (IPCEI) under EU state aid rules to support EU industrial research projects into green technologies”.

Explanation / Comment

“made in Europe batteries” are not exempted from state-aid rules (if we are referring to the European Battery Alliance - but to clarify) and our position is not to bend competition rules to favour EU champions (we prefer a level playing field for all market players).
